DESCRIPTION

An overview and analysis of the evolution of the Christian corpus. This course will emphasize the structural and literary content of the first writings about Jesus of Nazareth (Ephesians -2 Peter). Particular attention will be paid to the way the first century Jewish Rabbi Jesus became the Christ of faith. Theological, hermeneutical and liturgical disciplines will also be addressed.
