State Your Intentions and Reasons

Be clear about your plans and assure congregants of the ministry's bright and beautiful future.

Affirm the Good in the Setting

Affirm that your leaving is not personal and the ministry will survive your departure

 Offer an Exit Interview with Ministry Leaders

Leave on a good note and with a blessing for their future

Resolve Outstanding Conflicts

Clear the air, ask for and be willing to give forgiveness bury hatchets and plant gardens Plan Your Goodbyes

Be intentional about planning several opportunities for small group goodbyes

Disconnect and Be Transparent About it

Be clear about why this is important and be consistent in your actions

Find a New Place to Worship or Serve

Don't hang around or allow others to hang onto you.

THREE-WAY COVENANT

RETIRED MINISTER, LOCAL CHURCH, AND LOCAL ASSOCIATION OF THE UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST

This Three-Way Covenant is established between an Authorized Minister who has retired, their Local Church of membership, and the United Church of Christ as represented by an Association or Conference. This relationship is known as a three-way covenant, with each party accountable to and for the others. The purpose of this covenant is three-follows:

- 1. to strengthen, support and sustain the ministries of all the partners that share in this covenant;
- 2. to encourage mutual participation and accountability of and for the life of each by the others;
- 3. to observe, nurture, celebrate, and call forth the ministry of the Authorized Minister.
