- generally three congregational hymns (chosen by clergy)

Rehearse Pilgrim singers – soloist – volunteer musician(s) – and or hymn leader

- 9am Sunday's
 - Utilize Pilgrim's music library
- Singers and musicians contribute in worship as schedules and design allows
- Congregational hymn leader weekly
