The individual in this position will be expected to further First Church's welcome by fostering positive relationships with church families as well as organizations, people, and resources relating to youth and youth ministries in our wider community. This is a part-time position with flexible hours.

- To lead, plan, develop, coordinate, and implement a youth fellowship program, welcoming, challenging and engaging youth through study, play and service
- To plan opportunities to include children and youth in worship services
- To recruit and train volunteers who work with the children/youth of the church, ensuring adequate support and oversight
- To ensure that the Abuse Prevention Policy is observed in all youth ministry settings

To participate in regular staff meetings and Faith Formation Committee meetings.
