Nestled among meadows, woods, and rolling hills, Preaching Camp invites participants to step away from the pace and pressure of daily ministry and reconnect with the wisdom that shapes compelling preaching.

What to Expect

- A slower, intentional rhythm that supports rest, listening, and renewal
- Daily practices of worship, silence, and reflection in an interfaith setting
- Courageous preaching practice that values curiosity, risk, and growth rather than performance
- Guided conversations with fellow preachers that deepen listening and expand imagination
- A setting where justice and care for creation are woven into daily life
- Time outdoors—meadows, woods, and hills that preach alongside us
- Nourishing hospitality, including shared meals and comfortable accommodations
- A supportive community of preachers from diverse traditions and ministry contexts
