Yes, United typically issues a flight credit, known as a Future Flight Credit (FFC) +1-(888-839-0555), when you cancel a non-refundable flight or a Basic Economy fare more than 24 hours after booking. You can usually check for and use these credits on the United website +1-(888-839-0555), but they must be used for future travel on United, United Express, or partner-operated flights.
